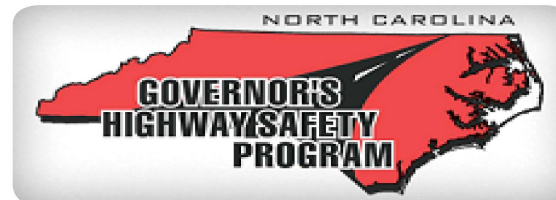

WHAT WE DO

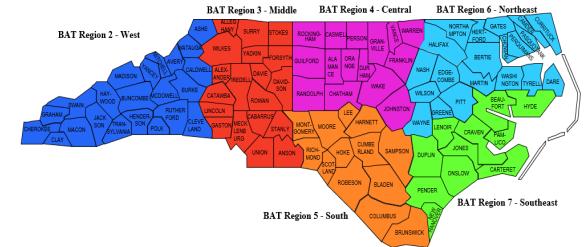
