<p>Question about bar within a food establishment we permit, I've been asking if there is food stored behind the bar beyond garnishes and where are the glasses cleaned and sanitized... if they are doing this at the bar are we checking this or not?</p>		<p>If no food prep is occurring in the bar area (other than what is allowed in the Law), then the area would be exempt from regulation. However, if food for the establishment is truly being stored in this area, the storage of the food must be assessed.</p>
<p>If we write an immediate suspension or intent to suspend, do we have to check the imminent hazard box? Do all suspensions have to fall under the imminent hazard definition?</p>		<p>You will need to check the imminent hazard box on the immediate suspension/revocation form if the situation is deemed an imminent hazard per 130A-2(3): "Imminent hazard" means a situation that is likely to cause an immediate threat to human life, an immediate threat of serious physical injury, an immediate threat of serious adverse health effects, or a serious risk of irreparable damage to the environment if no immediate action is taken.</p>
