Important Topics to Cover

Sanitation and Food Preparation


It is important to designate separate areas for food preparation and bottle preparation to prevent potential contamination. Provide sanitizers and hygiene protocols to minimize risk of spreading illness in shelter.

Diaper Changing



Locate areas for diaper changing facilities that are private, and accessible for care givers to use. Provide supplies such as wipes and single use gloves, and ensure convenient hand washing facilities are available.

Equipment and Toys



Inspect all toys and equipment to make sure it is in good repair. Have a procedure for cleaning and sanitizing toys after use. Make sure age appropriate toys are available and they are stored in a designated area.

Sanitation Supplies Needed

- Handwashing supplies soap, paper towels
- Single use gloves
- Baby wipes
- Cleaning and disinfecting solutions; (Bleach disinfectant can be made by mixing one tablespoon of bleach per one gallon of water)
