Instructions for File Upload to Lead Care FTP Site

Step 1: Go to: https://leadcare.ncpublichealth.com/

Step 2: Enter your Username and Password. Click on **Login**.



Step 3: Click on Upload

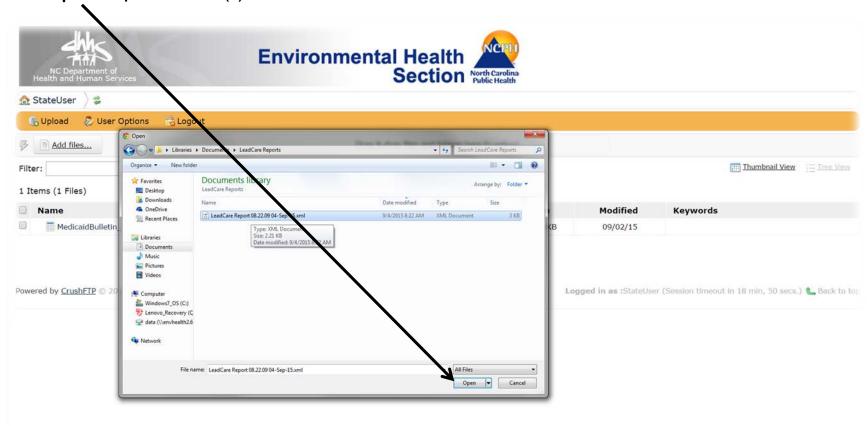


Step 4: You should see this message flash on the screen. Click on Add Files.

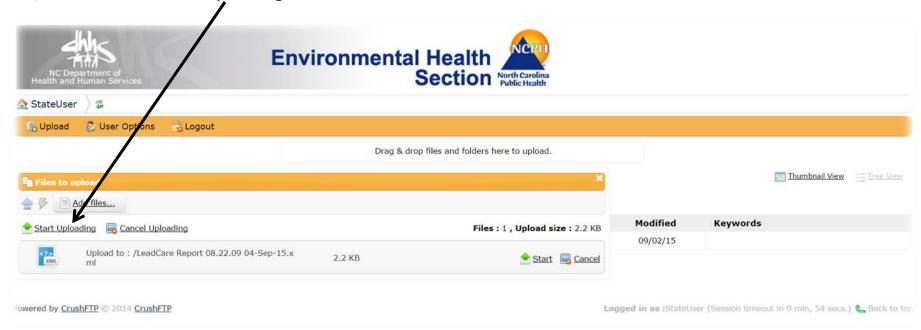


<u>Step 5</u>: Navigate to the appropriate folder (usually called "LeadCare Reports" if created by the LeadCare software). Select the file that you would like to upload by clicking on its name to make it visible in the "File Name" box at the bottom of the window. To select multiple files for upload, hold down the Ctrl key while clicking on the names of the files. For LeadCare Reports, these files should be in .xml format.

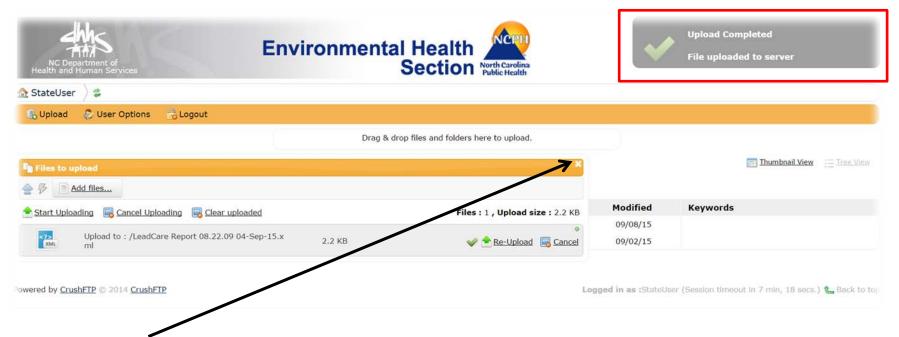
Click Open to upload the file(s).



Step 6: Click on the **Start Uploading** link.



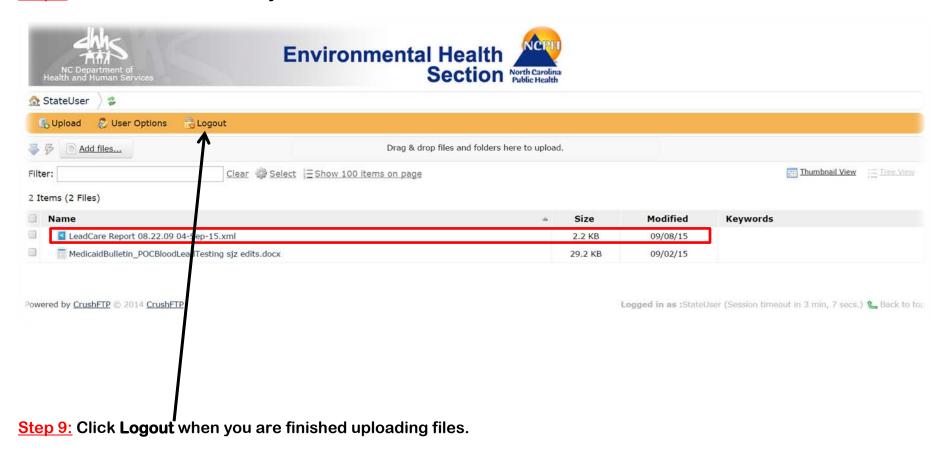
Step 7: You should receive a message that the upload was completed.

Step 8: Check to make sure that your file is listed in the main window.



Tips for New Users

- After entering your first two or three blood lead test results, upload the results file as a test file into the LeadCare FTP site. Notify Tena Hand at tena.hand@dhhs.nc.gov after you have uploaded your first file to the LeadCare FTP site. She will check the file to make sure that it transferred correctly, is in the correct format, and contains all of the fields required to fulfill state-mandated reporting requirements. Files not meeting these requirements may need to be re-entered and uploaded again.
