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BLOOD LEAD REFERENCE VALUE (BLRV)

Clinical follow-up for lead begins at the level of 3.5 µg/dL (as of March 21, 2022)

 Environmental investigations offered at 5 µg/dL and required at 10 µg/dL

WHAT IS A CASE? (DEFINED BY G.S. § 130A-131.7)

Elevated Blood Level (EBL)

Blood lead concentration ≥5.0 µg/dL determined by the lower of two consecutive blood tests within a 12month period

Confirmed Lead Poisoning (CLP)

► Blood lead concentration ≥10.0 µg/dL determined by the lower of two consecutive blood tests within a 12month period


