On November 1, 2004, you submitted a letter specifically stating:

- 1. All Orenco Flow Equalization Control Panels will have a Hand/Off/Auto switch.
- 2. They (*All Orenco Flow Equalization Control Panels*) will also have either two locking hasps or a locking hasp and two screws for securing the panel door closed.
