POSITION STATEMENT: Storage of Lunches Sent from Home in a Pre-K Program

Located in a School

PURSUANT TO: Rules Governing the Sanitation of Child Care Centers

15A NCAC 18A .2800

SOURCE: Children's Environmental Health

QUESTION/ISSUE: Are fully prepared lunches that are sent from home and

contain potentially hazardous foods required to be stored in a food preparation area as described in 15A NCAC 18A

.2804(k)?

DISCUSSION AND RATIONALE:

Administrative Rule 15A NCAC 18A .2804(k) states, in part, that "Lunches, snacks, and other meals containing potentially hazardous foods shall be refrigerated at 45 degrees Fahrenheit or below and stored in the child care center kitchen or approved food preparation area."

Rule .2801(17) defines "Food Service" to mean "the distribution of foods for consumption, including milk placed in a pitcher or other serving container, ice that is transported, stored and dispensed, the distribution of children's bagged lunches and snacks sent from home, and the use of utensils to prevent direct food contact."

RESPONSE/INTERPRETATION:

For licensed Pre-K Programs located in a school, "distribution" of lunches containing potentially hazardous foods sent from home, which are fully prepared, and do not require assembly or mixing of ingredients, heating or further manipulation by the child care staff is considered "food service." Therefore, no food preparation area is required. These lunches containing potentially hazardous foods sent from home must be refrigerated; however, this refrigeration does not require a food preparation area as described in Rule .2804(k).
