

Water Supply Wells

Public Water Supply Wells

(15 connections or 25 people for at least 60 days/yr)

Private Drinking Water Wells

(less than 15 connections and less than 25 people)

Small migrant housing, small day care, single family, shared, etc.

Noncommunity

(does not serve the same people all year round)

Community

(serves same people all year round)

Rest home, nursing home, subdivision, etc.

Transient (TNC)

(serves at least 25 people 60+days/yr, not on a regular basis and not the same people)

Gas station, church, restaurant, hotel, tattoo parlor, etc.

Nontransient (NTNC)

(serves at least 25 of the same people for 6 mo/yr but not year round)

School, large day care, hospital, etc.

Note: LHDs issue Construction permits and Certificates of Completion for Private Drinking Water Wells and TNC Wells. [15A NCAC 02C .0301 & § 87-85]

TNC and NTNC Wells may also be regulated by 15A NCAC 18A .1700
