What is NC Medicaid?

NC Medicaid is:

- a publicly funded health insurance program
- open to North Carolina residents who meet income, age, and immigration guidelines.

NC Medicaid - Does My Child Qualify?

The child must:

- live in North Carolina and have proof of residency,
- have proof of eligible immigration status,

•be age 0-18.

The <u>household</u> must:

meet the income guidelines.



NC Medicaid - Does My Child Qualify?

Monthly Income Guidelines: Updated April 1, 2024

Family Size	Medicaid for Children (0-18 years old)
2	\$3,595 or less
3	\$4,541 or less
4	\$5,486 or less
5	\$6,432 or less
6	\$7,378 or less
add for each additional child	\$946

Why should your child have health insurance?

Having health insurance has many benefits, including:

- Well-child visits
- Sick visits
- Services for children with special needs
- Mental health services
- Dental care
- Vision & hearing care
- Medical equipment & supplies
- Hospital care
- Immunizations
- Medications


