Hib Vaccine

(*Haemophilus influenzae* type b)

Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib) is a dangerous infection that can cause brain damage and deafness — especially in infants. **Before the vaccine**, Hib caused meningitis (brain infection) in 15,000 children every year, leaving many with permanent damage.
