Pneumococcal Vaccine (PCV)

Pneumococcal bacteria can cause infections in the brain (meningitis), lungs (pneumonia) and blood. It is especially dangerous to infants and toddlers.

Before the pneumococcal vaccine (PCV), every year this infection caused:

- 700 cases of brain swelling (meningitis)
- 17,000 blood infections
- 200 deaths
- 5 million ear infections in children
