Re:	On-line Reporting for ARLN Results: Carbapenem-Resistant Enterobacterales (CRE), Carbapenem-Resistant <i>Pseudomonas aeruginosa</i> (CRPA) and <i>Acinetobacter baumannii</i> (CRAB)

On Monday May 12th, 2025, the North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH) will cease faxing Antimicrobial Resistance Laboratory Network (ARLN) test results for CRE, CRPA, and CRAB and will institute reporting electronically through the Clinical and Environmental Lab Results (CELR) online reporting system. CELR allows submitters and providers to view and print NCLSPH reports at any time.

CELR is a secure network portal requiring specimen submitters to undergo registration and approval. A <u>Power Point tutorial</u> for registering an account with the NCSLPH CELR portal can be found on the NCSLPH website. Additional information about CELR is located on <u>NCSLPH CELR website</u>.

NOTE: CRE, CRPA, and CRAB test results are accessed by selecting "Enterics Lab" in the NCSLPH CELR portal. Please use the tutorial link provided for further information.
