Re: Rickettsia Testing at the North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health

Effective **May 31, 2025**, the North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH) will cease performing molecular testing for *Rickettsia* spp. Submitters that have *Rickettsia spp.* testing needs can submit serum and whole blood specimens for testing at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) through the North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH).
